Managing an investigation

The investigator/Prosecutors guide

- Stratagy- simply a plan of action to achieve a long term goal.
- Investigative actions these should be driven by the investigation not a check list.
- Advice- Team approach to decision making when developing the plan. Supplement the team with authoritative advice if required.
- Material-Ensure everyone understands the material its meaning and relevance to the investigation

- Objectives-each element of the strategy should have a clear objective. Avoid general or ambiguous statements like "carry out a sweep of the area".
- Methods & Resources- An outline of the methods for achieving an objective and the resources required should be given. Enough information to enable others to understand.
- Responsibility-Identify people to deliver the strategy or objective. If it involves a specialist technique or procedure ensure they have the information and understanding to carry it out effectively.

Review

Constant review is paramount with material coming into an investigation. Any strategy or objective should be subject to a formal review on a regular basis.

It is NOT an admission of failure to change an investigative direction in light of new material.
